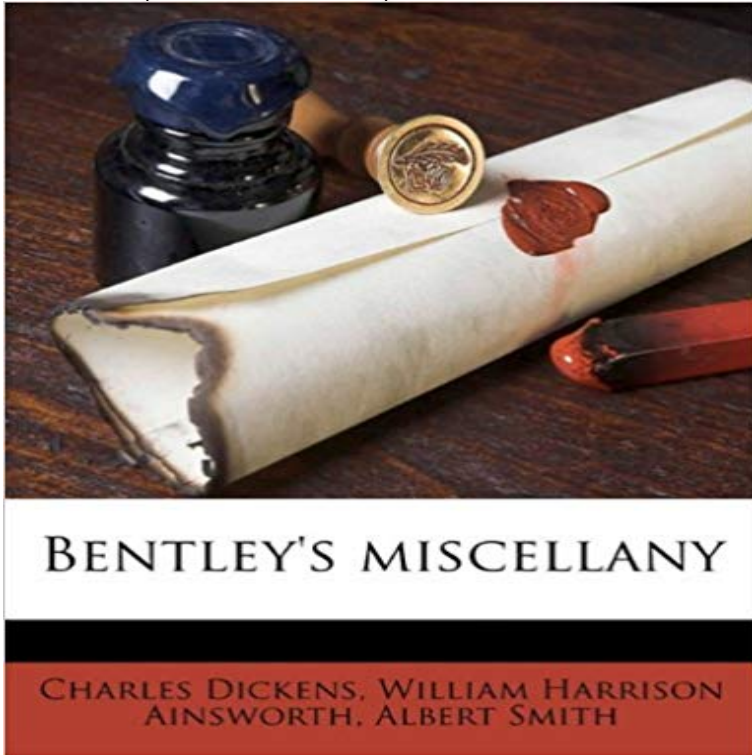


Bentleys miscellany
