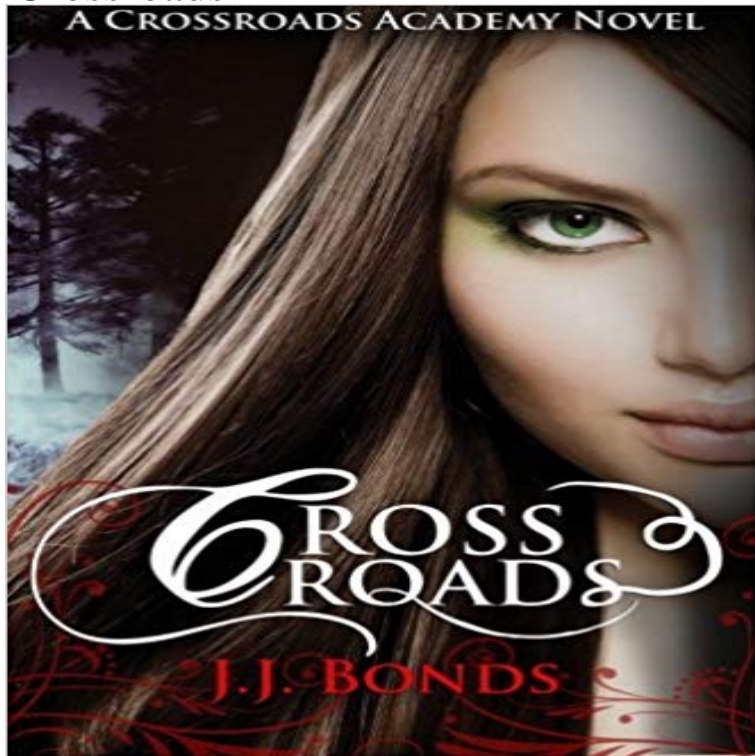


Crossroads
