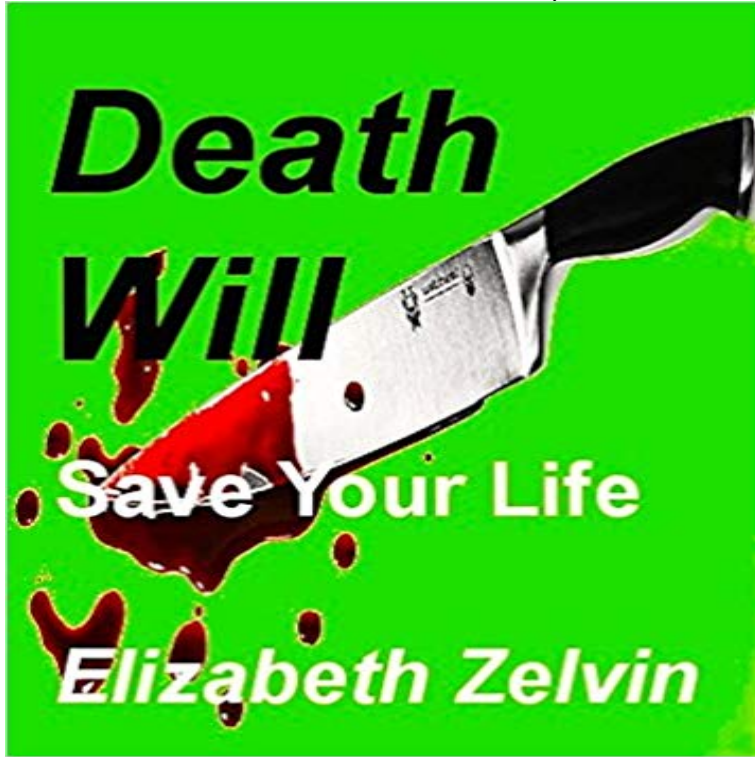


Death Will Save Your Life (Bruce Kohler Mysteries Book 4)
