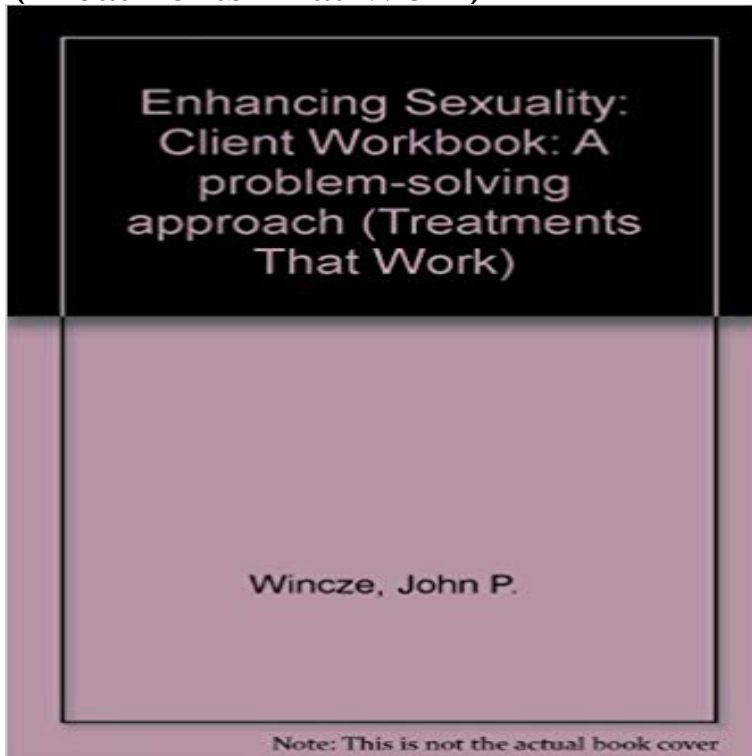


Enhancing Sexuality: A Problem-Solving Approach Client Workbook (Treatments That Work)
