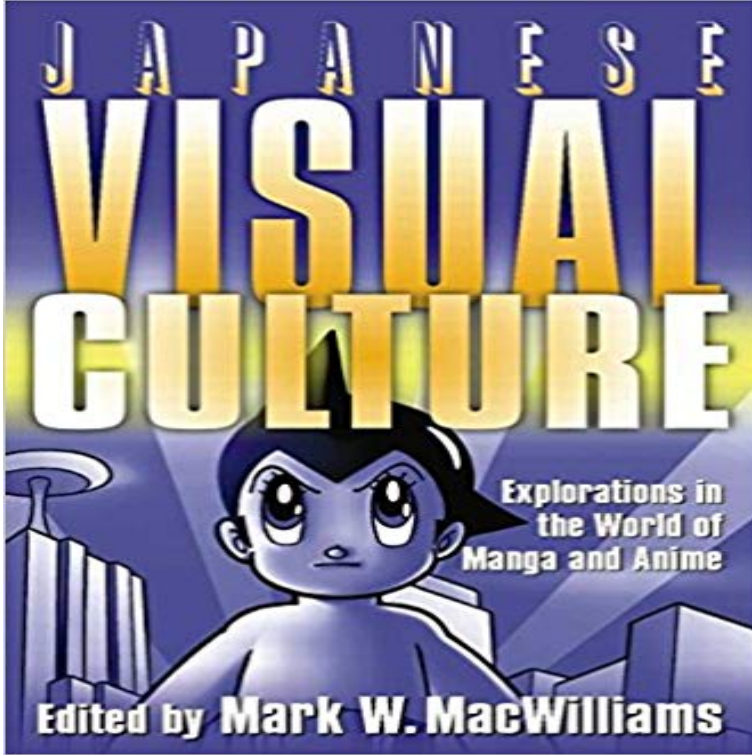


Japanese Visual Culture: Explorations in the World of Manga and Anime
