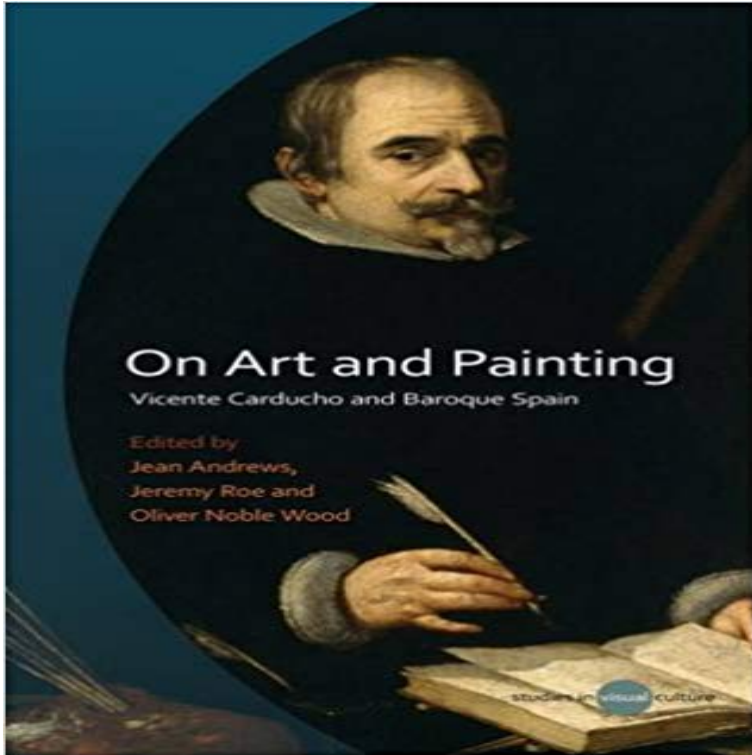


On Art and Painting: Vicente Carducho and Baroque Spain (University of Wales Press - Studies in Visual Culture)
