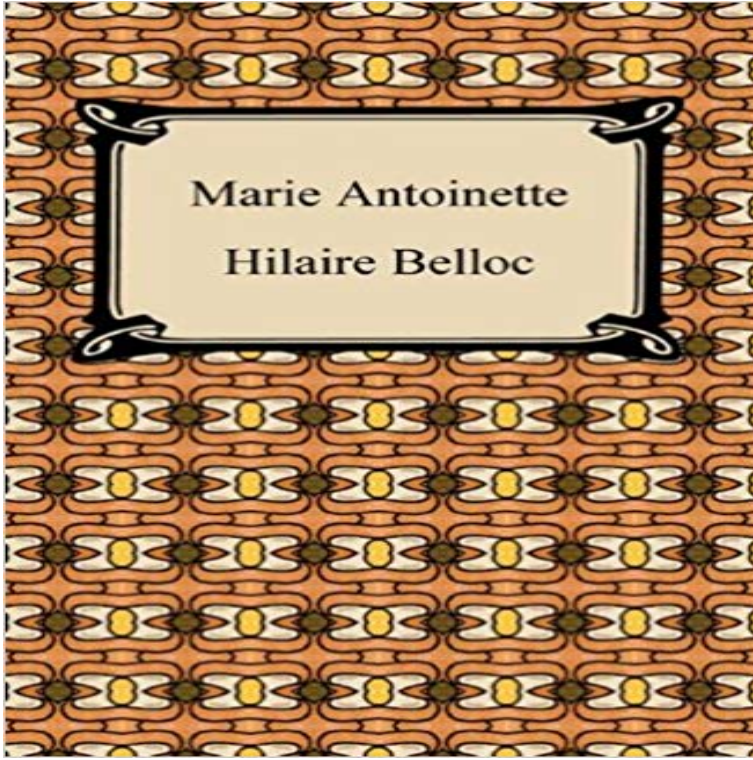


Marie Antoinette
