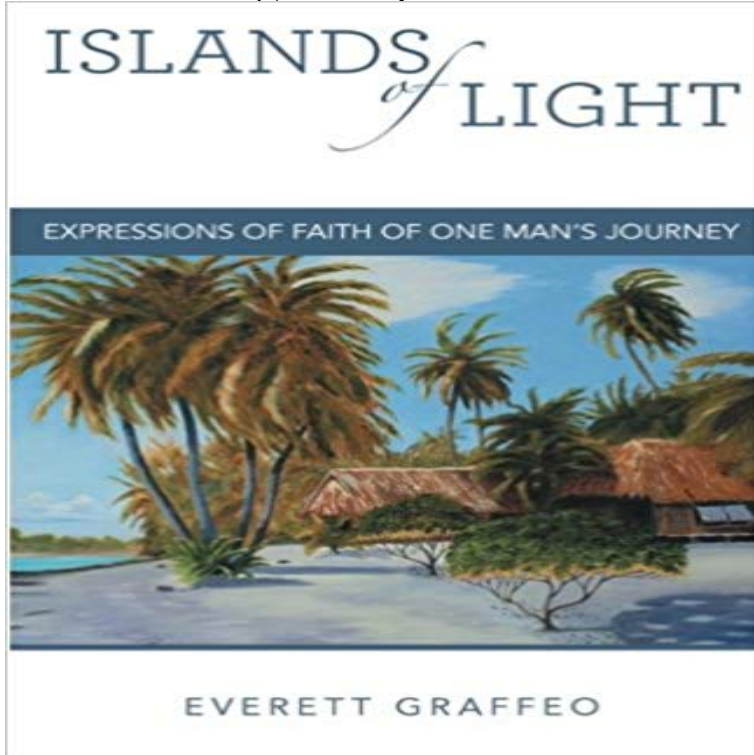


Islands of Light: Expressions of Faith of One Mans Journey
