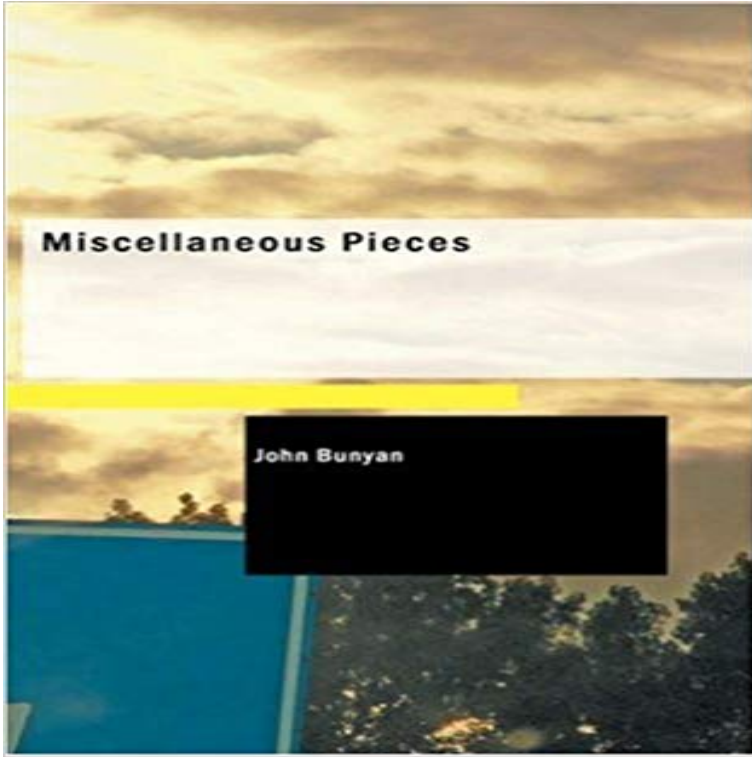


Miscellaneous Pieces
