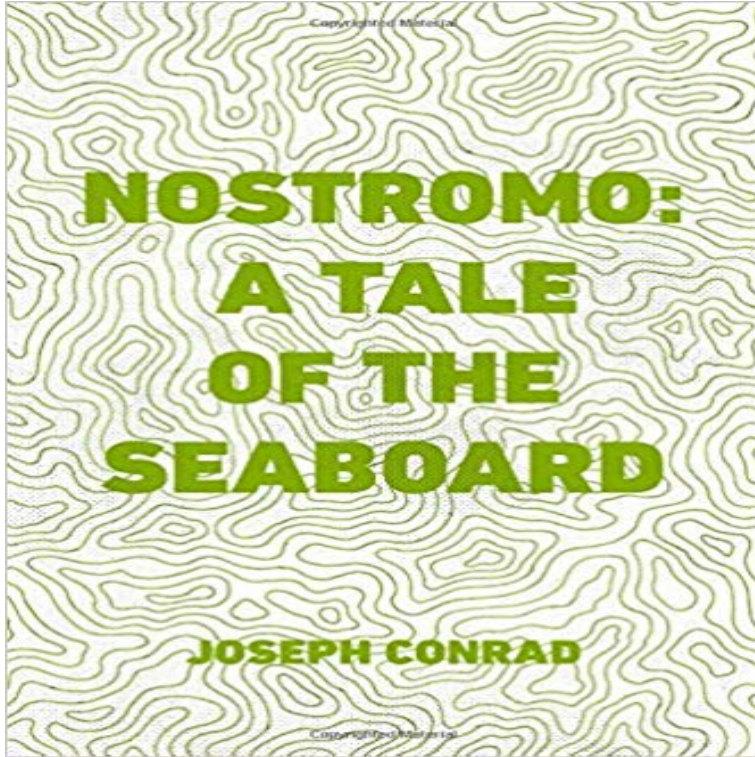


Nostromo: A Tale of the Seaboard

And though it was a second-language, Conrad mastered English prose.
