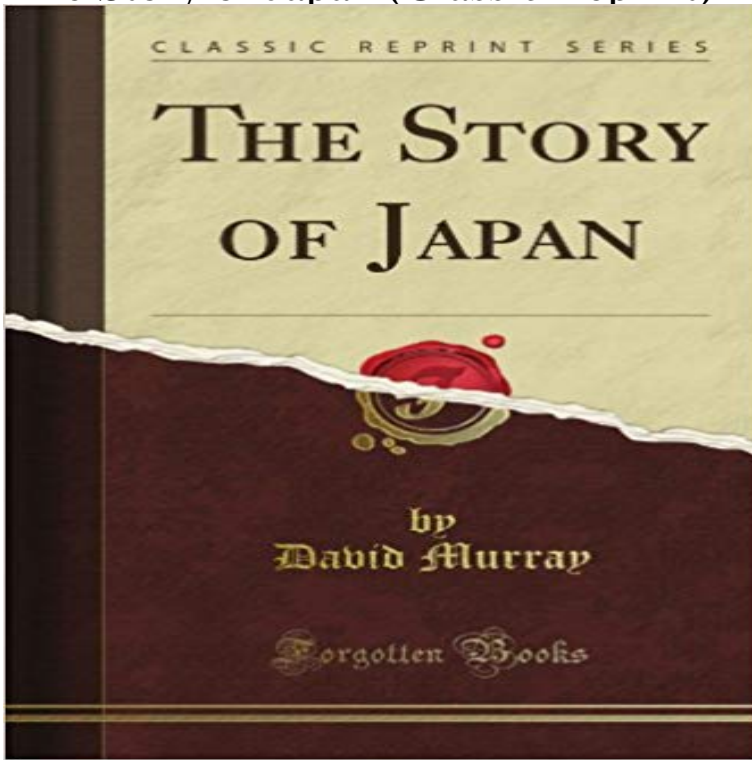


The Story of Japan (Classic Reprint)
